4 that by the terms of Decedent's Last Will duly admitted to probate
5 herein, said Decedent devised and bequeathed his Estate as
6 follows:

7 " FIFTH: I presently own 72% of the issued and
8 outstanding capital stock of Zoomar, Inc., a New York corp-
9 oration, located in Glen Cove, New York, I give, devise
10 and bequeath to my sister, ELIZABETH V. LOWEN two-thirds
11 (2/3rds) of my outstanding capital stock of Zoomar, Inc.,
12 which will then be equal to 48% of the issued and outstand-
13 ing stock of Zoomar, Inc. This should leave in my Estate
14 24% of the issued and outstanding capital stock of Zoomar,
15 Inc.

16 SIXTH: Prior to the distribution of my stock
17 in Zoomar, Inc. as set forth in Article FIFTH, I direct
18 that my Executors vote my stock in Zoomar, Inc. so that such
19 corporation shall pay to every one of its employees employed
20 in Glen Cove, New York, the sum of One hundred (\$100.) Dol-
21 lars for each year of service to the Corporation as a bonus
22 to said empl oye. In addition to the bonus set forth herein,
23 my Executors are directed to vote my stock in Zoomar, Inc. so
24 that said Corporation will pay as an additional bonus the sum
25 of ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.) DOLLARS to BERNARD E. MOSKOVITZ.

26 SEVENTH: The remaining shares of my stock in
27 Zoomar, Inc. (amounting to 24% of the issued and outstanding

Weizmann Institute of Science, Rehovot, Israel, in

1 memory of Dr. Frank G. Back, with a plaque in dimen-
2 sions of no less than one square foot.

3 American Society for Technion-Israel
4 Institute of Technology, Inc., 1000 Fifth Avenue, New
5 York City, upon condition that a room be dedicated in
6 the Technion Institute of Technology, Haifa, Israel,
7 in memory of Dr. Frank G. Back, with a plaque in dimen-
8 sions of no less than one square foot.

9 The Albert Einstein College of Medicine
10 of the Yeshiva University, New York City, upon condi-
11 tion that a room be dedicated in memory of Dr. Frank
12 G. Back, with a plaque in dimensions of no less than
13 one square foot, which plaque shall mention that Dr.
14 Frank G. Back was a personal friend of Dr. Albert
15 Einstein.”

16 THE COURT FURTHER FINDS, ORDERS, ADJUDGES AND DECREES that
17 the assets described below in the Final Decree of Distribution
18 compromise the entire Estate on Hand for Final Distribution.

19 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court
20 that said HARRY SHEREFF AND LOUIS SHEREFF, as Co-Executors as
21 aforesaid, have in their control belonging to said Estate as the
22 BALANCE OF ESTATE ON HAND FOR FINAL DISTRIBUTION, cash in the sum
23 of \$202,110.14 and 445 shares of common stock of BACKOPTICS MFGR.
24 CO.; that said Third and Final Account and Report be and the same
25 is in every particular, and as rendered and presented for
26 settlement, hereby finally allowed, approved and settled; and that
27 all acts of said Co-Executors, as in said Third and Final Account,
28 Report and Petition set forth, are hereby approved and confirmed;
